Re: Sirens

The Tuxedo Fire District would like to announce that the replacement of its three district sirens will be completed by Friday, June 20th. The \$41,000.00 project was made possible when the Tuxedo Fire Commissioners applied for and received a \$30,000.00 grant from Senator Tom Morahan.

The sirens, an Eclipse 8 model made by Federal, have a maximum sound pressure level of 115 decibels at one hundred feet. The sirens will be located in the area of the Towns three fire departments; Tuxedo Park Company #1, Sterling Forest Company #2 and Eagle Valley Company #3. The new Indian Point Siren located in the East Village, is not part of this project.

In an attempt to balance public tranquility with responder safety, the sirens will sound seven times on fire calls from 6:00 am - 9:00 pm, three times between 9:01 pm and 5:59 am and once at noon.
